#### **Community Leader of Distinction:** Nominate a community leader who is age 24 or older.

An honor bestowed upon a Tribal community leader (*Example Individual: Tribal Program Coordinators, Staff, Partners, Judicial Staff, Advisory Committee Members, Tribal Leadership that support program initiatives, Elder, Cultural Leader or programmatic partner*) that has contributed and supported the vision of OJJDP which is a nation where children are free from crime and violence. Honoree demonstrates exemplary community leadership efforts to support Tribal youth. This individual serves in the areas of prevention, intervention, diversionary court processes, youth engagement, youth leadership or other Tribal juvenile related field of service. Honorees are selected from communities supported by Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation funds in Purpose Area 8-Tribal Juvenile Healing to Wellness Courts or Purpose Area 9- Tribal Youth Programs. Special consideration will be given to current OJJDP Tribal Grantees. Recognition committee will review and announce selected candidates via the OJJDP Tribal Youth Training and Technical Assistance Center website on or before December 1, 2018.

Deadline: Nominations must be submitted by November 15, 2018.

Honorees are selected from communities supported by Coordinated Tribal Assistance Solicitation funds in Purpose Area 8- Tribal Juvenile Healing to Wellness Courts or Purpose Area 9- Tribal Youth Programs. Special consideration will be given to current OJJDP Tribal Grantees. Recognition committee will review and announce selected candidates via the OJJDP Tribal Youth Training and Technical Assistance Center website on or before December 1, 2018.

Deadline: Nominations must be submitted by November 15, 2018.
